
The Assassination of President Lincoln

Election of 1864


- Abraham Lincoln defeats George McClellan


Abraham Lincoln (NU)



George McClellan (D)





The Assassination


- What does assassination mean?

- When?
 - ☐ April 14, 1865
- Shot by?
 - John Wilkes Booth
 - Tom Cruise of his day.
- Where?
 - □ Fords Theater
- Lincoln was the first President to ever be assassinated
- There are a number of Conspiracy theories surrounding the assassination.

The Conspiracy

- What is a conspiracy?
 - A plot to carry out some harmful or unlawful act
 - There were several Conspirators in the plot to assassinate Lincoln
 - This conspiracy was a plan to kill Lincoln along with other members of the government

Why Kill Lincoln?

- Booth was a Southern patriot.
- Didn't want to reunite with the Union
- Thought killing Lincoln would end any chance of Reconstruction
